Objectives:

By the end of this Institute, participants will be able to:

- 1) Describe the history, structure, and workforce needs of the early childhood community.
- 2) Describe emergent issues facing early childhood intervention.
- 3) Describe strategies to integrate families of infants and young children with disabilities into state wide early childhood intervention, planning, development, and evaluation.
- 4) Describe strategies to collaborate across systems that serve infants and young children and their families.
- 5) Describe leadership roles and responsibilities for the Part C and B(619) coordinators to facilitate the inclusion of infants and young children with disabilities and families into state and local early childhood initiatives, including: personnel development, QRIS, and child and family benchmarks and outcomes.
- 6) Develop a state action plan, timeline, and outcomes to use in their state to facilitate the integration of infants and young children with disabilities and families into state and local early childhood initiatives.
