Using Leadership Competencies to Impact Policies, Practice, and Personnel for Inclusive Services in Early Childhood

As a result or attendance, participants will be able to:

- 1. Describe current and emerging state issues in Part C and B/619 programs through poster displays by each participating state team.
- 2. Describe the ECPC activities and outcomes to date.
- 3. Identify evidence based leadership competencies.
- 4. Describe challenges and solutions for early childhood leaders.
- 5. Review and describe the use of core cross disciplinary personnel competencies.
- 6. Apply evidence based practices in adult learning to pre-service and in-service state activities.
- 7. Describe finance systems to support an infrastructure for personnel development activities.
- 8. Discuss the use of integrated data systems to track and evaluate personnel policies and practices.
- 9. Describe and apply a systems approach to national and state policy development, implementation and evaluation.
- 10. Develop a logic model to guide state training and TA initiatives.
- 11. Use the ECPC/ECTA personnel framework to assess and target components of an Integrated and Comprehensive System of Personnel Development in each state.
- 12. Use individual state planning time to evaluate state plans and incorporate strategies provided by institute faculty and participants.
- 13. Revise state plans for Part C/619/early childhood collaborations to insure services for infant and young children with disabilities and families are integrated into state and local early childhood initiatives through the identification of objectives, resources, timelines and outcomes.
