What do families need?	What do practitioners need?
Education	Do not go into a meeting without meeting the parent first
How to partner	Universal
Mentor (a vetted person)	Knowledge
Social Awareness	Understanding boundaries
Understanding Boundaries	Families as faculty – family center curriculum
People First language	Cultural awareness/sensitivity
Telling your story (how to tell your story)	Child safety and social emotional
Meeting families where they are	Knowing the resources – accessibility Being in the community, geography
Have a practitioner explain the “why” when asking questions	Don’t use acronyms
Share resources, i.e. CDC website – forms for families to use to ask questions	Everyone being equal
Child safety education	Parents should be an equal partner (helping them understand how)
