This **Service Coordination Leadership Institute** will focus on developing strategies with members of the National Service Coordinator Training Workgroup to prepare, empower and support service coordinators as they carry out service coordination responsibilities outlined in Part C of IDEA.

Objectives:

By the end of this Institute, participants will be able to:

- 1) Describe the history, structure, and workforce needs related to service coordination in early intervention.
- 2) Describe emergent issues facing the provision of high quality service coordination in early intervention.
- 3) Describe strategies to prepare, empower and support service coordinators as they partner with families of infants and young children with disabilities across states and systems.
- 4) Describe strategies to plan, develop, and evaluate activities to prepare, empower and support service coordinators through both statewide initiatives and across national initiatives.
- 5) Describe strategies to collaborate across states and systems that prepare, empower, and support service coordinators as they partner and with families and serve infants and young children in early intervention.
- 6) Describe leadership roles and responsibilities for National Service Coordination Training Workgroup members as they partner with each other and their respective Part C Coordinators or other administrators responsible for preparing, empowering and supporting service coordinators.
- 7) Describe strategies to measure the impact of service coordination leadership initiatives and identify methods to gather feedback from service coordinators, their supervisors, and other stakeholders including families.
- 8) Develop a national and state action plan, timeline, and outcomes to use to facilitate the integration of high quality service coordination into state, local and national early intervention initiatives.
